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COPD Clinic Referral

The COPD clinic is a multidisciplinary clinic that provides services that include specialized assessments and COPD education. The services are provided by a Certified Respiratory Educator/Registered Respiratory Therapist and an MD all in partnership with the patient's family physician. Initial visits occurring post hospital discharge with follow-up visits q3-4 months.

Referral to the COPD Clinic will include the following services:

Confirmation of diagnosis and monitoring changes in airflow obstruction

- Pre and Post Spirometry (At initial visit, 3 month F/U then yearly)

Evaluation of ability to cope in his/her usual environment

Review treatment (inhalers, antibiotics, steroids maintenance and acute)

Review understanding of treatment regimen (includes use of Action Plan; smoking cessation, vaccines and exercise) Assessment of inhaler technique

Assessing need for long-term oxygen

- Oximetry at every visit
- ABG's and Home oxygen assessment will be performed if Spo2 <90% on room air

Evaluating the capacity to do physical activity and activities of daily living

- 6 minute walk test

Evaluating symptoms via mMRC (Medical Research Council Dyspnea Scale) or COPD Assessment Test (CAT^{TM}) Evaluating severity via BODE Index
